What are we learning this month?

Literature

In September, we'll read *The Cabin Faced West* by Jean Fritz. It's about a girl moving to the American frontier and adjusting to pioneer life. This book helps students learn about early American history and the importance of perseverance. We'll have daily 15-minute read-aloud sessions to improve reading skills like intonation and pronunciation.

Spanish

Students are learning greetings, colors and numbers through songs, games and repetetion

Geography

We'll learn how Earth's shape influences human choices, starting with landforms and geography tools. We'll explore connections between location, landforms, climate, and resources, starting with our local area and the Northeast U.S.

Math

Students will create calendars, practice skip counting, and learn to read clocks to the nearest five minutes. They'll also use number lines, read temperatures, and explore fractions of an hour. The month will cover addition, subtraction, fact families, and place value, including regrouping and rounding numbers.

Speech/songs

We'll practice public speaking by reciting poems and famous sayings, focusing on fluency, articulation, and confidence.

Science

We'll explore the scientific method through experiments in Unit A, focusing on plants and animals, especially seeds and animal groups.

Lesson 1: Words with one vowel, consonant blends, and silent letters Lesson 2: Adding suffixes to words ending in silent E

Lesson 3: Plural forms for words ending in S, F, SH, CH, and X

Lesson 4: Adding suffixes to words ending in Y
